Title	CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS - REVISION OF MEMBERS' ALLOWANCES SCHEME		

1. PURPOSE/SUMMARY

To present to Council changes to the Members' Allowances Scheme following the Leader's announced Cabinet changes.

2. KEY ISSUES

- The Council has a Members' Allowances Scheme which was approved by Council in November 2011.
- The Leader proposes two amendments to the scheme regarding Upper and Lower level allowance payments and the use of special payments with no increase in the overall budget.
- These amendments are set out within this report and, if agreed, will take effect from today's meeting (13 September 2012).

3. RECOMMENDATION

That the Council approves the amendments to the Members' Allowances Scheme as recommended by the Leader of the Council and authorises the Chief Solicitor to make such typographical amendments as are necessary to produce revised clean text copies of the Constitution.

(i) Basic Allowance

The Leader of the Council shall be able to award special payments to members not in receipt of a portfolio holder or chairmanship SRA for carrying out special projects. Payments will not be more than £1,500 individually and The total yearly budget will not exceed £6,000.
