## 1. BACKGROUND/INTRODUCTION

On the $1^{\text {st }}$ August 2013 the Chief Executive received notification from Councillor David Patrick that he withdrew from the Lib Dem Alliance group of Fenland District Council and wished to be an independent member under the name Fenland Independent Alliance.

## 2. CONSIDERATIONS

The rules relating to political proportionality in relation to membership of committees are set out in the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and the supporting regulations.

For the purposes of the regulations a political group must consist of two or more members who have signed a declaration to that effect. Where one or more groups exist the relative proportions of the groups should be used in allocating seats on committees.

The current distribution of the 40 current members of the Council within the group structures is:

| Conservative | 34 | $90 \%$ |

| Lib Dem Alliance | 2 | $5 \%$ |
| Truly Independent | 2 | $5 \%$ |
| Unaligned | 2 |  |

It should be noted that political groups can appoint members who are not aligned to a political group, or indeed aligned to another group to seats allocated to them under the political proportionality rules.

## 3. COMMITTEES AND PANELS

The current allocations of seats for Overview and Scrutiny, Planning, Licensing and Conduct Committees remain unaltered. The revised allocations for Staff, Appointments and Corporate Governance Committee are set out in the following table.
