Decision to be taken:

To award a contract to enable the Port Authority to undertake supply of Automatic Identification System with recording, Time zero Coastal Monitoring record and Replay, Time zero Coastal Monitoring single licence and consumable materials. Circa £28k.

Decision:

After considering all options available and after consultation with Procurement, Finance and Legal, a decision has been made to award a Contract to Charity & Taylor.

Reason for the Decision:

Regulatory Framework: The International Maritime Organization (IMO) mandates the use of AIS under the SOLAS (Safety of Life at Sea) regulations. Specifically, AIS must be fitted on all ships of 300 gross tonnage and upwards engaged in international voyages, cargo ships of 500 gross tonnage and upwards not engaged in international voyages, and all passenger ships regardless of size.

Alternative Options Considered (if appropriate):

contractor for supply of vessel Automatic Identification System
