

## FORWARD PLAN OF KEY DECISIONS (covering the period 1 November 2024 to 28 February 2025 at a minimum)

Paper copies will be made available for inspection and purchase via the address and telephone number set out above

## What is a Key Decision?

A Key Decision means an Executive decision (i.e. one taken by the Cabinet or an individual member of the Cabinet) which is likely to

- result in the authority incurring expenditure which is, or the making of savings which are, in excess of £100,000 either on its own or in partnership with other organisations; or
- be significant in terms of its effects on communities living or working in an area of the District comprising two or more wards.

The full definition of a Key Decision can be found in the Council's Constitution, which can be found on the Council's website.
