

Your Job and Getting to Work

Your employer will work with you to make sure you can stay safe at work – this may include things such as



Different start and finish times



One way routes through the building where you work



Limiting the number of people who can use a kitchen area at any one time



Providing more places for you to wash or sanitize your hands



Putting up barriers between you and the people you work closely with



If you or someone you live with gets symptoms of Covid-19 you **must** get a test

What are the symptoms of Covid-19?



A high temperature



A new cough that does not stop (continuous)



A loss of smell or taste

How to get a test for Covid-19



Visit a walk in or drive through testing unit – you do not need to book, just turn up

If you have to self-isolate, you must not go to work. Let your employer know that you will not be able to go to work. We understand this can be hard - there is advice and support to help you do this.

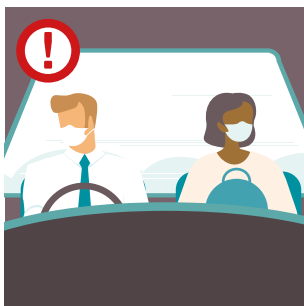

Share the transport with the same, small group of people each time



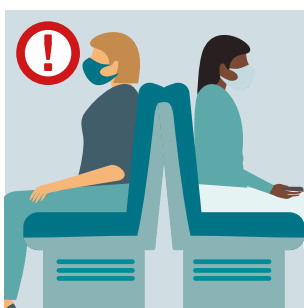
All wear face coverings (passengers and driver)



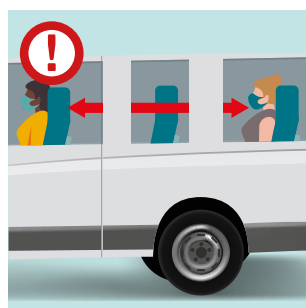
Open windows for ventilation



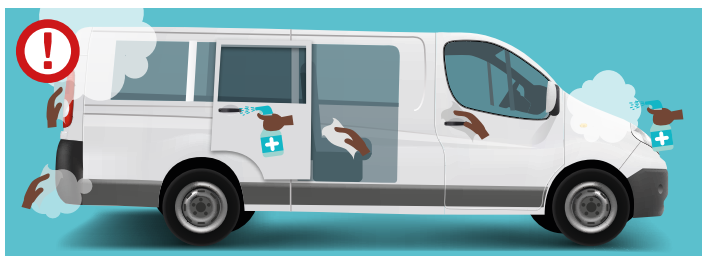
Travel side by side or behind other people



Face away from each other



Try to sit as far away from others in the vehicle



Clean the vehicle between journeys using standard cleaning products.
