If you have to, please follow these simple steps:**



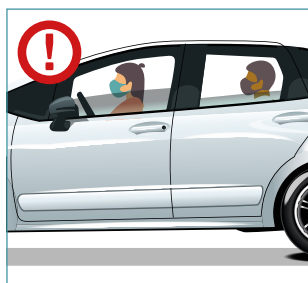
Wash or sanitise your hands before and after journeys



All wear face coverings (passengers and driver)



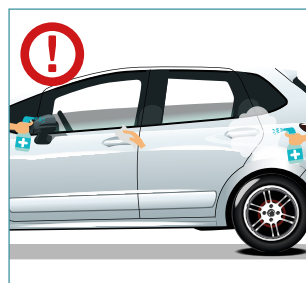
Keep the vehicle windows open for ventilation



Share the transport with the same, small group of people each time



Try to sit as far away from others in the vehicle, including the driver



Clean car surfaces after every journey, including handles, seatbelts and other areas that people may touch

Stay at home for **10 DAYS**



Anyone in your household should isolate for **10 DAYS**



Don't leave your home



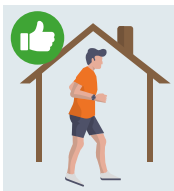
Don't go out to work, school, or to public areas

Don't go out to buy food or other essentials



Take exercise at home or in your garden, if you have one
